*Jackson Municipal Airport Authority
Notice for Public Comment
Intention to Amend an Application to Impose and Use a Passenger Facility Charge
at Jackson-Evers International Airport*

Jackson Municipal Airport Authority (JMAA) is posting this public notice as part of the passenger facility charge (PFC) application process under 14 CFR § 158.24 for the Jackson-Evers International Airport (JEIA). JMAA will be notifying the Federal Aviation Administration of its intent to Impose and Use a Passenger Facility Charge. As part of this procedure, JMAA is providing the following information regarding proposed PFC Amendment No. 99-03-C-03-JAN:

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In 1999 PFC Application 99-03-C-00-JAN was approved by the FAA for impose and use of a PFC. The application consisted of two projects: Terminal Renovations and Rehabilitate East Parallel Taxiway. This amendment concerns only the Terminal Renovations project. In the initial application, the project was approved for PFC authority to impose and use in the amount of \$2,477,870. On December 4, 2002, FAA approved amendment No. 99-03-C-01-JAN to the application. This amendment increased JMAA's impose and use authority for the Terminal Renovation project to a new total of \$10,074,953 and, consequently, the total application authority increased to \$11,925,562. Amendment No. 99-03-C-02-JAN was approved by the FAA on August 5, 2003. This amendment increased the PFC charge level to \$4.50.

As a result of JMAA's refinancing of its debt in 2005 and changes in the use of funds between Pay-Go and debt service, JMAA now has updated debt service numbers and is seeking to increase its impose and use authority for this project by \$542,090 to a new total of \$10,617,043 and, consequently, total application authority to \$12,467,652. There has been no change in the approved scope of the project. Because the increase to the project's cost exceeds 25 percent of the originally authorized amount, this change requires opportunity for public comment and air carrier consultation.

PFC LEVEL

The amended application will retain a PFC level of four dollars and fifty cents (\$4.50) at the Airport.

PROPOSED CHARGE EFFECTIVE DATE

JMAA estimates the charge effective date for this amended PFC application to be April 1, 2000 (or upon expiration of collection of PFCs for currently approved applications, whichever comes first).

ESTIMATED CHARGE EXPIRATION DATE

JMAA estimates the charge expiration date for this amended PFC application to be January 1, (or until collected revenues plus interest thereon equal the allowable costs of the approved projects, as permitted by regulation).

ESTIMATED TOTAL PFC REVENUE

JMAA estimates the PFC impose and use authority to be increased by \$542,090 to a new total of \$10,617,043.

AUTHORITY POINT OF CONTACT
