JACKSON-EVERS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Long Term Passenger Parking and Shuttle Service

JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI—October 24, 2005: The Jackson Municipal Airport Authority (JMAA) announced today the opening of additional long term parking on Highway 475.

Since Hurricane Katrina, many evacuees, relief workers, volunteers and commuters are utilizing Jackson-Evers International Airport. For the convenience of long term passengers, a new long term economy lot will open on Highway 475 adjacent to the Mississippi Air Cargo Logistics Center on October 25, 2005 at an affordable rate of \$5.00 per day which includes shuttle service to the airport. The long term lot and shuttle service will be operational twenty-four hours a day.

According to Dirk B. Vanderleest, Executive Director of the Jackson Municipal Airport Authority, “although construction and the impact of Hurricane Katrina have temporarily changed the parking operations at Jackson-Evers International Airport, we are still committed to support and accommodate the needs of the traveling public and displaced citizens of Mississippi and Louisiana.”

Disabled passenger shuttle service is available twenty-four hours a day seven days a week. Anyone needing disabled shuttle service should call Jackson Parking Associates at (601) 932-6520.

We encourage passengers to check baggage at curbside on the departure level, park and ride the shuttle to the terminal building. Please arrive two hours before scheduled departure.
