Jackson-Evers International Airport Spring Break Parking and Travel Tips

Jackson Municipal Airport Authority will accommodate potential overflow parking requirements during this high demand period.

Should the Parking Garage, Surface Parking Lot, and Long-Term Lot on Highway 475/Airport Road fill, personnel and/or signage will be posted to direct customers to an open area.

We would also like to remind travelers to pack smart. Don't over pack bags as the TSA screeners may have to open them for examination. Remember 3-1-1 for carry-ons = 3 ounce bottle or less; 1 quart-sized, clear, plastic, zip-top bag; 1 bag per passenger placed in screening bin. We have courtesy bags available to passengers at the screening checkpoints. You can declare larger amounts of necessary liquids. Prescription medications, baby formula and milk (when traveling with an infant or toddler) are allowed in quantities exceeding three ounces and are not required to be in the zip-top bag. Declare these items for inspection at the checkpoint. If in doubt, put your liquids in checked luggage.

Come early and be patient. Heavy travel volumes and the enhanced security process may mean longer lines at security checkpoints. For more tips and rules on TSA procedures visit their website at www.tsa.gov.
